Frequently Asked Questions

WHAT SETS APART BVA's SENIOR SECTION APPROACH?

We believe that it is the balance between innovative approaches and a rigorous academic program that enables our students to excel academically. We also have a strong focus on supporting our students to develop emotionally and socially. Our approach allows our students to achieve exceptional O-Level results and secure admissions into the finest colleges and universities in Pakistan and across the globe.



The Senior Section experience includes a wide range of academic subjects, many extracurricular activities, a competitive and structured sports and athletics program and many learning opportunities outside the classroom, including domestic travel within Pakistan and an annual international excursion for our graduating class.

WHY IS THERE AN ADMISSION PROCESS FOR CLASS VII AND Class X?

Class VII and Class X are traditionally intake years at educational institutions. Since we receive more applicants than available spaces, an assessment is utilized to identify those candidates most likely to benefit from the Senior Section experience.



WHAT IS THE ADMISSION PROCESS FOR CLASS VII AND Class X?

The admission process consists of an assessment test in three subjects, English Language, Mathematics and Urdu. A candidate may also be interviewed by the selection committee on a case-by-case basis.

WHAT IS THE FEE STRUCTURE IN THE SENIOR SECTION?

An admission fee and security deposit is taken at the time of admission and the tuition fee is charged quarterly from August of the enrolment year. The admission fee reduces at higher grade levels as students are spending fewer years at Bay View if they enroll in the Senior Section.

ARE ADMISSION OPPORTUNITIES AVAILABLE AT OTHER GRADE LEVELS IN THE SENIOR SECTION?

Occasionally, admission opportunities may arise at other grade levels. Applicants can be placed on a waitlist by visiting <https://bva.edu.pk/senior/> and completing the appropriate Admission Inquiry Form.



WHEN ARE ADMISSION DECISIONS MADE FOR CLASS VII AND Class X?

Registration and testing will take place in March. A first round of early admissions will be released in the week after the testing date. Admitted applicants are advised to take advantage of early admissions to allow the best chance of securing a spot in August. A second round of admission offers may be made in April, at the discretion of the selection committee.





DOES BVA OFFER MERIT-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS?

In Class X, merit-based assistance can be considered for students who transcend their peers in sports or academics. A cover letter stating your case for consideration for merit-based assistance can be submitted with your Class X admission registration and must include evidence to support your case. For example, if a student has represented his/her city, province or country in a sport, certificates, official rankings and invitation letters to competitions may be attached to the cover letter as evidence.
